

According to Ryazan State Medical University admission rules for 2020 a foreign citizen is admitted to the University on a competitive basis. A candidate who passed all entrance examinations is obliged to provide the following documents packed in one envelope:

1. **Results of compulsory preliminary medical examination** (it is obligatory to do medical examination in the Russian Federation)
2. **Receipt for tuition fees and hostel accommodation payment** (according to the contract it should be done within three days upon signing the contract)
3. **Receipt for medical insurance payment, Chest X-Ray result**
4. **4 photos** (3x4size)
5. **Original educational document/certificate** (supplement with marks if available)
6. **True copies of educational documents mentioned in the clause 5 with notarized translation into the Russian language** (translation should be done in the Russian Federation)

These copies should be legalized (Ministry of foreign affairs of the country where documents were issued and the Russian Consulate in the country where documents were issued).

Or

In case country where an educational document was issued has ratified the Hague Convention of 1961 it is necessary to provide the true copy copy of the apostilled educational documents. The apostille should confirm the right of the notary to do the true copies. In case the Russian Federation and a country where the educational document was issued signed a mutual legal assistance treaty providing legalization cancellation it is necessary to provide the true copy of the educational document (with supplement if available) notarized by Ministry of foreign affairs of the document issuing country. 7. Certificate concerning recognition of education in a foreign country (Equivalency Certificate) or letter proving the right of a candidate to continue his/her studies at a university.

In case a country issued an educational document and the Russian Federation signed an agreement concerning mutual recognition of educational documents the procedure of recognition is provided by the University where the documents were submitted itself. To do that it is necessary to provide a letter from municipal or regional educational department, Ministry of education of a document issuing country proving the authenticity of the document and the right of a candidate to continue his/her studies in the universities of a document issuing country. Original letter should be legalized as mentioned in the clause 6. The list of the countries signed the agreements concerning mutual recognition of educational documents with the Russian Federation in accordance with the information provided at the web-site of the Federal State Budget Organization "The main state expert center of education evaluation":

Owners of the educational documents issued by other countries should provide certificate of foreign education recognition (Equivalency Certificate) – official confirmation of educational level achieved by a candidate in his/her country with the aim to provide him/her ability to continue high education in the Russian Federation. Decision about foreign education recognition is accepted by Federal Education and Science Supervision Service. There is a state duty for Equivalency Certificate issue and amount of it is set by the Tax Code of the Russian Federation.
